1 The Board endorses the creation of parent organizations as appropriate means of achieving
2 effective and maximum feasible involvement of mothers, fathers, and other guardians of students
3 in the affairs of our schools. The Board expects all staff members, but most particularly
4 principals, to work closely in harmony with the officers and directors of all parent organizations
5 in the pursuit of the following goals:

- 7 1. To involve parents and school personnel in a cooperative and sustained system of
8 activities which will increase the educational opportunities of the children both in school
9 and at home,

- 11 2. To improve school/home relationships by enabling parents and school personnel to (a)
12 define their relationship to each other; (b) define their roles as they pertain to the children
13 served by the schools; and (c) identify family needs and resources, including those of
14 community as well as school needs and resources.

- 16 3. To provide teachers and administrators with opinions and viewpoints that will lead to a
17 better analysis of the needs of students and more relevant program planning, and

- 19 4. To develop the skills needed by school personnel to function effectively in a working
20 relationship with parents and other community members.
