1 The Board adopts this Code of Ethics as recommended by the Tennessee School Boards
2 Association as a guide to its members as they provide educational leadership for the youth of our
3 state. The Board further agrees that ethical issues regarding the Board or its members may be
4 referred to the TSBA Ethics Advisory Council.

7 **ARTICLE I. MY RELATIONS TO THE CHILDREN**

8
9 Section 1. I will at all times think in terms of “children first,” always determining other
10 important things according to how they affect education and training of children.
11

12 Section 2. I will seek to provide equal educational opportunities for all children regardless of
13 ability, race, color, sex, creed or location of residence.

16 **ARTICLE II. MY RELATIONS TO MY COMMUNITY**

17
18 Section 1. I will endeavor to appraise fairly both the present and future educational needs of
19 the community and to support improvements as finances permit.

21 Section 2. I will represent at all times the entire school community and refuse to represent
22 special interests or partisan politics.

24 Section 3. I will endeavor to keep the community informed about the progress and needs of
25 the schools.

28 **ARTICLE III. MY RELATIONS TO TEACHERS AND PERSONNEL**

30 Section 1. I will support the employment of those persons best qualified to serve as
31 employees and insist on a regular and impartial evaluation of all staff.

33 Section 2. I will support and protect personnel in performance of their duties.
34

35 Section 3. I will not criticize employees publicly but will make such criticism to the Director
36 of Schools for investigation and action if necessary.

39 ARTICLE IV. MY RELATIONS WITH OTHER BOARD MEMBERS

41 Section 1. I will recognize that authority rests only with the Board in official meetings and
42 that the individual member has no legal status outside of such meetings.

44 Section 2. I will refuse to make promises as to how I will vote on a matter which should
45 properly come before the Board as a whole.

47 Section 3. I will make decisions only after full discussion of matters at a Board meeting.

49 Section 4. I will respect the opinion of other members and will accept the principle of
50 "majority rule."

53 ARTICLE V. MY RELATIONS WITH THE DIRECTOR OF SCHOOLS

55 Section 1. I will support full administrative authority as well as responsibility for the
56 Director of Schools to properly discharge all professional duties.

58 Section 2. I will support Director of Schools' accountability for working and requiring staff
59 to work within the framework of policies set up by the Board.

61 Section 3. I will refer all complaints and concerns to the Director of Schools.

64 ARTICLE VI. MY RELATIONS TO MYSELF

66 Section 1. I will be informed about my duties and responsibilities and current educational
67 issues by individual study and through participation in programs providing needed
68 information, such as those sponsored by my state and national school boards
69 associations.

71 Section 2. I will avoid being placed in a position of conflict of interest, and will refrain from
72 using my Board position for personal or partisan gain.
